



In Sight Triangle: Only vertical objects 12" or less in diameter, from 3.5 to 10 feet above street grade.

Sight Triangles at Intersections				
Major Approach >	Arterial Street		Any Other Street	
Minor Approach >	Street, not Alley	Alley or Driveway	Street, not Alley	Alley or Driveway
L =	300'	200'	150'	100'
R =	150'	100'	75'	50'

Exceptions:

One-Way Streets - On one-way streets, sight triangles do not apply at corners where traffic does not approach the intersection. On one-way streets, if the major approach traffic comes from the RIGHT, then the LEFT sight triangle dimensions shall be applied to the RIGHT corner.

Principal Buildings - Sight triangles do not apply to principal buildings located in conformance with building setback requirements of the Zoning Ordinance.

Utility Devices - Authorized utility devices -- poles, control boxes, traffic signs and signals, etc. -- are excepted from strict conformance with sight triangles. However, the location of these devices should adhere to limitations as closely as possible.
